


#### **Christmas Jumper Swap**

Friday 12th December—KS1 Nativity in school time 12.30-1.30pm –EARLY FINISH WHOLE SCHOOL 1.30pm


Monday 15th December- Whole School visit to St Olcan's Parish hall to watch Christmas performance
