### IMPORTANT: Parentpay booking changes

You will notice a number of changes to how Ten2 club and Breakfast Club are booked. The old payment items have been removed and you now need to book following the steps below.

## Ten2Club booking instructions:

- Log in to ParentPay as normal and click on the 3 horizontal lines at the top left hand of the screen on your mobile.
- 2. Click on active payment items
- Click on the 'view' box beside your child's name
- Scroll down to the YELLOW 'book meals and places' bar and click on it
- 5. From the dropdown select **afterschool** & then select the date range
- Click 'make or view bookings' which will bring up the booking page
- Click on the day/days you need to book and it should turn green.
- IMPORTANT—you must now complete the booking by clicking 'confirm booking' & pay

#### Breakfast Club booking instructions:

(You will be able to book this item from Saturday 13th.)

Follow steps 1-4 as above

5. From the dropdown select **breakfast** & then select the date range

Follow steps 6-8 as above.

\*\*You will see that you now can choose from a daily option of 15,30,45 or 60 minutes. Please select the correct allocation from the dropdown list. A sign in register is kept by William and we will check that all bookings made correctly cover the length of time your child attends club according to the time they were signed into club. You may find if you have not made the correct booking that it will be manually adjusted resulting in either a credit or a debit on your account.

Can we remind you that Clubs need to be booked in advance, at the beginning of the week, to allow staff to prepare materials & food.
