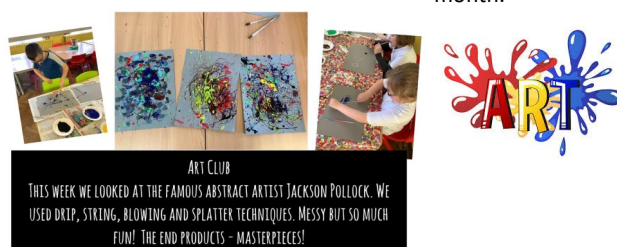


Duck Race: PTA also decided that although we will not be running our Summer Fair this year we will be having our Duck Race. This will be held on Friday 8th April. More details to follow later.
