Residential trip—We have organised our P6/7 residential trip which will take place slightly earlier this year from 17-19 April 2023. We have tried to keep the cost as low as possible but due to an increase in price at the Share Village and in the cost of transport we have had to increase the price slightly to £220 per pupil. This will be payable in instalments with an initial £50 deposit required to secure your child's place. 25 places are available and in the event of oversubscription priority will be given to P7 pupils. P6 places will be allocated after this on receipt of the deposit until
